1 The age-standardised mortality rates for 2016 are standardised to the 2013 European Standard Population, expressed per 100,000 population. Age-standardised rates are used to allow comparison between populations which may contain different proportions of people of different ages. ASMRs are based on mid-2016 population estimates.
